**FEDERAL DEFENDANTS' UNOPPOSED  
MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATIONS**

Federal defendants Alberto Gonzales, Attorney General of the United States, and Karen Tandy, Administrator of the United States Drug Enforcement Agency, (“Federal Defendants”) respectfully move the Court for permission to file a brief that exceeds the twenty (20) page limit in LR 7.1(h). Federal Defendants seek an additional fourteen (14) pages to be allotted to their Memorandum in Support of Their Motion to Dismiss (“Federal Defendants’ Memorandum”).

Good cause exists for Federal Defendants’ Memorandum to exceed the current page limitation. Plaintiff’s Original Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief (dkt. no. 1) (Jan. 16, 2007) is thirty-two pages long and sets forth ten different causes of action that raise numerous statutory and constitutional claims and issues. Additional pages are required to effectively address each of plaintiff’s claims, which Federal Defendants’ Memorandum does. Federal Defendants have not sought any previous extensions of page limitations, and plaintiff consents to Federal Defendants’ request for additional pages.

Accordingly, for the reasons stated above, Federal Defendants respectfully request that the Court grant their unopposed motion to exceed page limitations and allow Federal Defendants

a total of thirty-four (34) pages for their Memorandum in Support of Their Motion to Dismiss.
