PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATIONS

Plaintiff Carl Olsen respectfully moves the Court for permission to file a brief that exceeds the twenty (20) page limit in LR. 7.1(h). Plaintiff seeks an additional three (3) pages to be allotted to his Memorandum in Support of his Motion for Summary Judgment as to the State of Iowa Defendants ("Plaintiff's Memorandum").
